In the village of Chimutu, located near the capital of Malawi, Lilongwe, there is a primary school of about 500 children who, when it's not raining or too hot outside, take turns meeting for classes under a straw canopy.

What is the Chimutu Project?

There is great news: the new school is underway. Construction began last July during a summer humanitarian project that a group of Italians and local Malawians participated in. During the project a well was also drilled to provide safe and clean drinking water to the village and students.

What will be our part this summer?

We will be returning to Chimutu to finish building the school: pouring concrete floors, plastering walls and building bathroom facilities for the students.

How you can be involved?

You can join us for part or all of the summer project in Malawi or help in raising funds to buy necessary building materials: wood, cement, tin roof sheets, and furniture.

What is the project cost?

Food, housing, and transportation in country:

- Two weeks 500 Euro
- Four weeks 850 Euro
